



Connecting to MICDI Server via Web Browser

Open your web browser and go to <http://www.micdi.com>

Look to the top right of the menu bar for the “Client Access” tab, and click it.

You will be taken to the server log in page. Click the “Remember Me” option and bookmark this page for quick access.
